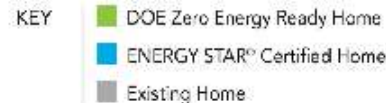
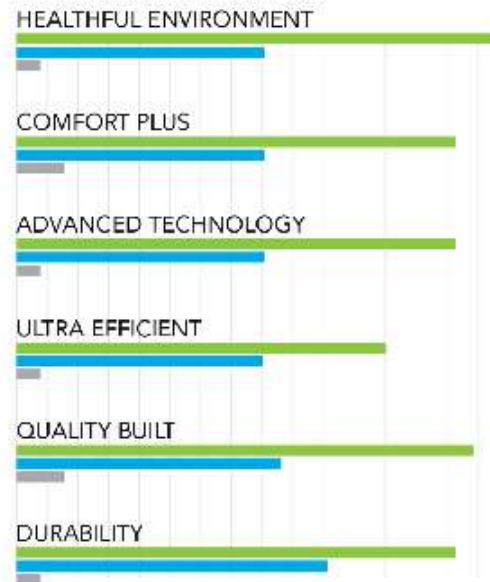
What is the DOE Zero Energy Ready Home™ Label?

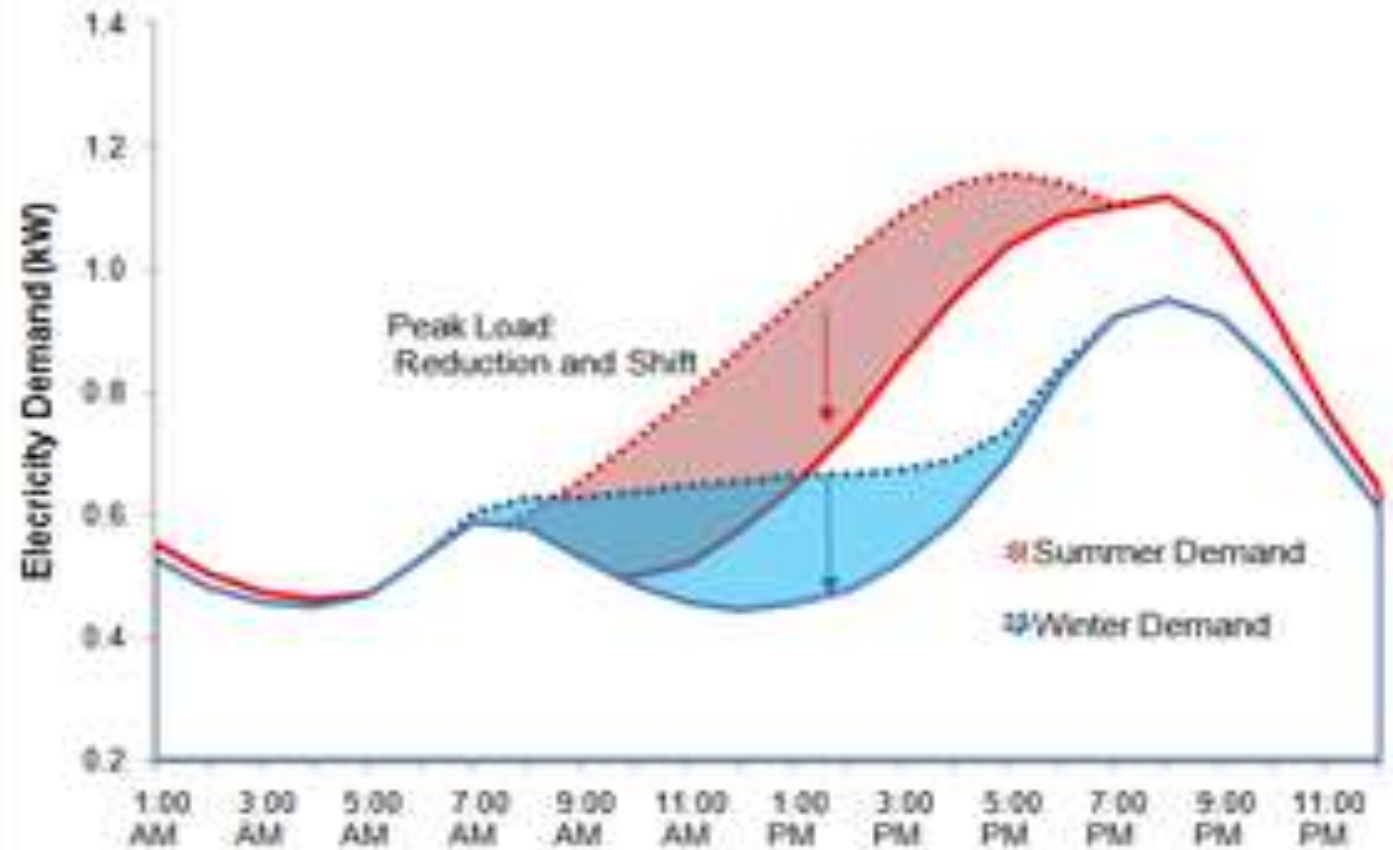

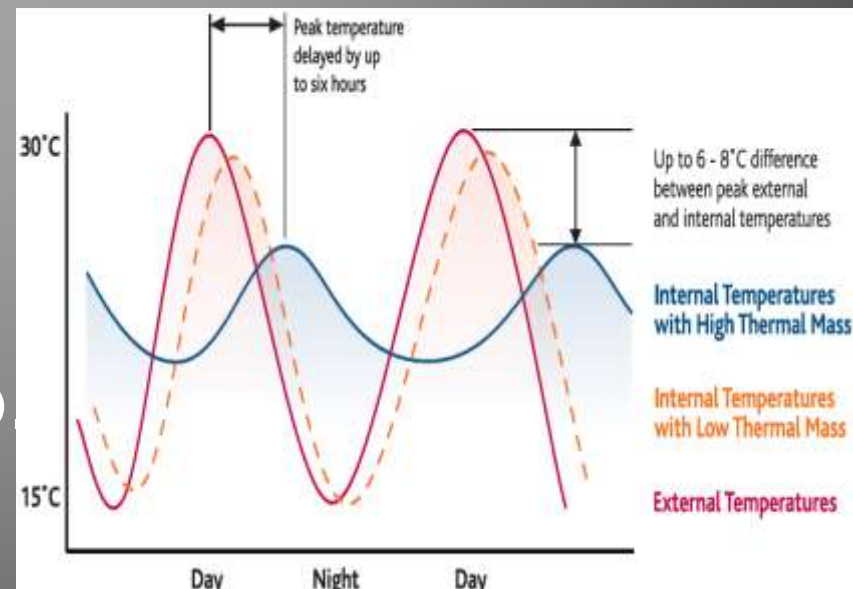
SCE Residential Peak Load Shift Impact of 10% PV Generation

Energy Management

1. Smart ventilation (off peak)
2. Isolated Thermal mass / phase change
3. Thermal storage (heatpump HVAC precool off peak)
4. Low solar heat gain (reflective / vented cladding materials)
5. Smart appliances
6. Large hot water storage w/ heat pump
7. West facing solar.

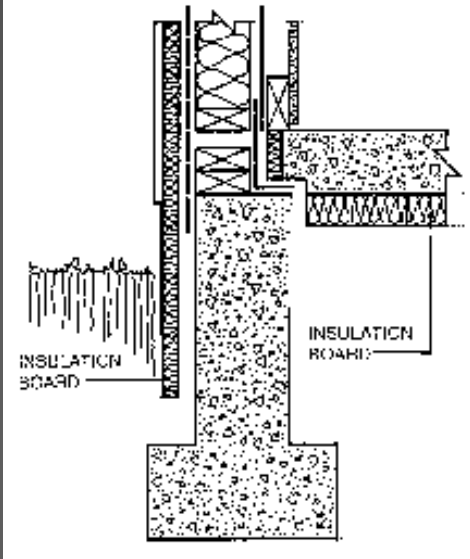
